
Chicago Tutor/Mentor Program Locator – Making it Work:




This platform has not been working properly since late 2013. Help me fix it, or rebuild it. Apply it to your own city.

Tutor/Mentor Program Locator Screen Shots

The http://www.tutormentorprogramlocator.net site was built by different developers between 2004 and 2009, using html and older databases. It's not working properly, and could be completely rebuilt. The screen shots in this and two other pdfs are intended to show what is on the site now, that would need to be rebuilt in an new site.

I have Front Page, which is no longer supported by MS. Thus, editing content on html page is a problem.


Links on the sides work.

(1)The Map Gallery is hosted on the program locator site and was built using html. It works.

(2) This opens a set of pages used to collect and edit data about tutor/mentor programs.A PDF is available to show these pages.

(3) This opens to a screen that enables users to search for programs in specific zip codes.

(4) This opens to the OHATS documentation system.


(5) The Interactive map page – built w/html is not opening.

(6) This opens asset map page – not opening

(7) Government map page – not opening. Good NEWS! When volunteers got this to work in early Nov, they fixed the boundaries showing districts so they were working.

(8) Rest of Story page – built with html. Working

(9) Introduction – this is animation that shows how program locator works. Does not use actual screen shots, or have voice track. I'd like to create a YouTube adding narration.




This is what you should see when you open the program locator. At the lower right is what were were seeing when the data was not showing up on the map. This had been fixed in early Nov. Not working as of 11/19..

The tabs on the left appear on the Asset Maps and Government Maps.

1)The map at lower left shows how boundaries for zip code and community areas should show up on the map.

2) The poverty data is based on 2000 census and needs to be updated

3) Schools data is 2007 & 2008. Needs to have more current information and have a layer showing all public and charter schools.



This is what you see now when you open the asset map pages (*when they are opening properly*). Each of the six category areas open to a map showing businesses, colleges, universities in the area, along with tabs that enable you to add layers from each category to create a map showing multiple assets in the city, or in specific parts of the city.

Below is an example of the tabs for the bank page, along with a map showing all of the banks as they would appear on the map.





This is what you see now when open the government maps pages.


Across the top you see three categories. When you click into each the top three boxes a new page, showing boundaries should appear, as shown below. You can highlight specific districts. Since data base not working, info on map does not show up.





We never were able to build map views for the three categories shown on bottom role.

Once the Program Locator is working properly, this is the next step.




If we can create a portal that encourages donations to programs, and that enables us to report donation amounts by program, and by map region, we can increase our impact on flow of resources and improve the flow of information about programs to the portal.


